Guidelines for Organizing Daily Schedules and Routines

1. Create an overall daily schedule that is predictable yet flexible.

- * Organize the day around regular daily events and caregiving routines.
- * Follow the overall daily schedule consistently.
- * Accommodate children's natural rhythms and temperaments.
- * Provide a smooth flow from one interesting experience to the next.

2. Incorporate active learning, including adult support, into each event and caregiving routine.

- * Be patient with children's intense interest in things around them-understand *their* sense of time.
- * Value children's need for sensory exploration in each event and routine.
- * Share control of the day with children by giving them appropriate and limited choices during transitions and routines; offer open-ended play and exploration.
- * Be alert and responsive to children's communications and talk throughout the day.
- * Work as a team to provide ongoing support to each child throughout the day.
- * Look at and understand children's actions and communications through a developmental lens.
