It's HighScope registration time! Again, another great opportunity for scholarship-funded training in the **HighScope Approach** is being offered through the Early Years Count Education Initiative of the Community Foundation of St. Joseph County. This full scholarship is for directors, teachers and assistants who are currently working in a St. Joseph County early childhood center, preschool, or registered ministry and do not qualify for Indiana state funding (T.E.A.C.H.). To date, over **814** early childhood professionals in St. Joseph County have received training in HighScope Pre-K!!

HighScope is 8 credit hours and will be held on Fridays from 8:00 a.m. to 2:45 p.m. January-May, 2020 at Ivy Tech's South Bend campus. The training is two segments (HighScope I and HighScope II; *both* are required to complete training).
