Overview

HighScope's large group time is a segment of the day when adults and children share an experience as partners. Large group time, which lasts 10-15 minutes, contributes a sense of community in the classroom. It is a time when everybody comes together to participate in music and movement, songs and cooperative games.

PQA-II-H The program has a time each day for large group activities that reflect and extend children's interest and development

- There is a daily time set aside for large group activities
- Throughout large group time, children contribute their own ideas and participate at their own developmental levels (individual children move in their own ways, try out one another's ideas for singing and moving and take turns leading others)
- All adults participate with the children at each large group time

Goals for moving forward

- 1. Plan group large group experiences ahead of time
 - Children's interests
 - Curriculum content
 - __Cooperative play and projects
 - Events currently meaningful to the children
- 2. Use a beginning, middle and end to support children through each part of a large group time activity

4.	Encourage children to explore and use materials at their own developmental pace
